

Volunteer Role: Ride for Refuge Coordinator

DESCRIPTION: Ride for Refuge Coordinators collaborate with Ratanak's Ride Team to promote the Ride in their community and provide support for local Riders. The Coordinator promotes the Ride to past and potential local Riders through a variety of initiatives. They provide a personal connection for Riders leading up to the event to encourage fundraising and engagement.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Collaborate with the Ride Team initiatives.
- Identify and explore opportunities for local promotion of the Ride.
- Communicate with past Riders to encourage them to sign up for the Ride.
- Identify, recruit and support local team captains to build a Ride team.
- Support current Riders in their engagement and fundraising.
- Take initiative to increase understanding of Ratanak International, human trafficking, and Cambodia through training opportunities, general communication (newsletters, etc.) and independent learning.

SKILLS & REQUIREMENTS:

- Excited about the value and potential of Ride for Refuge.
- Strong leadership, communication, and organization skills.
- Ability to encourage and engage others.
- Demonstrates value of teamwork (building and collaborating).
- Strong understanding and knowledge of Ratanak International.

TRAINING & RESOURCES:

- In-person training (as available) and online training resources.
- Promotional material (key messaging, banner, brochures, etc.) as needed.
- General communication (prayer bulletin, newsletter, social media) and a monthly update email.
- Opportunity to engage with a Cambodia Training Trip (as available).
- Support from Volunteer Manager and access to other Ratanak staff as needed.

TIMELINE: Ride for Refuge Coordinator is an ongoing volunteer position with a primary workload during the 3-months leading up to the Ride for Refuge, which happens annually at the end of September or beginning of October.
